Early Literacy Plan, Monica Lewis: Last year, implemented schoolwide screening and new curriculum to provide targeted reading instruction. Trained paraeducators & completed regular progress monitoring. All worked to carry us into the 20-21 school year. Time requirements for literacy drive our master schedule. Core instruction in k-3 includes: Phonological Awareness, Phonics, Fluency, Vocabulary, Comprehension, Oral Language & Writing. Literacy Goals to remain the same as last year.
